
Square Graver Sharpening with the Dual Angle fixture



Face 600 grit Right Heel ceramic

Left Heel ceramic

The 90° Square Graver



The graver should be mounted with the heel side down and the rotation angle to 45° and the toolpost angle to 15°. Sharpen on the ceramic wheel until a short heel of approximately 1/32" is achieved. Repeat this operation for the opposite side of the heel by setting the rotation angle passed zero to 45° and sharpen on the ceramic wheel, checking both sides for symmetry.

KEEP 'EM SHORT

Keeping the heel short will allow precise cutting of tight radiuses without the back of the tool dragging and spoiling the edge of the cut as it makes turns.. Also, a short heeled tool can be accurately positioned for straight cutting lettering, borders, design, etc., without leaving a long heel mark trailing behind the starting point.
